Members who have not resigned on or before such date shall be deemed to have renewed their membership and shall be obligated to pay the annual dues, assessments and taxes applicable to the type of membership held by them in the preceding year. Resignations received after January 31st shall be of no force and effect for that year and failure to pay the applicable dues, assessments and taxes shall result in termination of the membership in bad standing. By reason of the foregoing there shall be no refunds, partial or otherwise, of dues, assessments or taxes paid to any member failing to resign on or before January 31st of the year in which such resignation is intended to take effect.

All Full Members receive one free rental of the clubhouse per year. Any future rentals will be a fee of 60% of current rental fee. Dining Room only (\$30) Ball Room only (\$120) Both Rooms (\$150)

Non-Members: Ballroom Rental Fee for a private party:

\$50 ... Dining room only \$200 ... Ballroom only \$250 ... Both rooms

ASSESSMENTS

Special Note Regarding Assessments:

Two assessments for 2026 were passed by the Membership at the 2025 Annual meeting. These will only be levied against active 2026 members who were members for any length of time during 2025.

Golf Equipment Improvement Assessment	\$100.00
Capital Improvements Assessment	\$150.00

Any new assessment for 2026 would be levied against all 2025 members within the restrictions outlined above.

SPECIAL NOTES

- **All Members must check in at the Pro Shop before every round.**
- **Regarding voting privileges, only one vote per family is allowed.**
- **It is the Board's desire to increase membership and control expenses so that no assessments would be necessary in the future.**
- **Employee Memberships: For 2026: the Treasurer, Secretary, Greens Superintendent and Pro Shop Manager shall receive single golf membership status.**

GOLF COURSE/PRO SHOP

Golf Course Open Play for the General Public on Fridays & Saturdays during summer when proshop is open

Cart Pass Membership \$625.00 + \$45.31 (tax) = \$670.31

The cart membership is per individual and is for unlimited cart usage (contingent upon availability) for the entire golf season. Not for student members

Guest & Non-Member Green and Cart Fee:

18 holes \$20.00 18 holes with cart: \$30.00 without cart: \$20.00
9 holes \$13.00 9 holes with cart: \$25.00 without cart: \$15.00

To rent a cart: Must sign cart waiver and be at least 16 years old with a valid driver's license.

Annual Range Pass for Members Only:

Range fees per Bag Member 2 Bags \$10.00 Non-Member One Bag \$10.00

Amenities of Regular & Young Single / Family Membership:

- Unlimited golf, not including carts, for Husband/Wife (or significant other) and children still in school 22 years old and under based on available tee time.
- Member rates on driving range.
- Unlimited guest privileges. Member must play with guest; Guest must pay green fees and cart fees if riding.
- Eligible to play in all open or member only tournaments/events based on tournament criteria
- Restaurant privileges for all members of the family listed above.
- Free rental of the Clubhouse Ball Room for one (1) member event.
- Club voting privileges for one (1) family member.
- Responsible for all approved Golf Equipment and Capital Improvement Assessments.

Amenities of Club Supporter Membership:

- Restaurant privileges for all members of the family (Husband/Wife/Significant Other) and children.
- Golf privileges limited to three (3) 18 hole rounds, unlimited range, with green, cart, and range fees
- Free rental of the Clubhouse Ball Room for one (1) member event.
- Club voting privileges for one (1) family member.
- Responsible for any approved Capital assessments related to the clubhouse only, assessment amount limited to \$25.00 in any given year.

Student membership Rules Orientation

Amenities:

- Unlimited golf, not including cart, for the student member only based on available tee time
- Member rates on driving range; or, student rate if member High School golf team
- Eligible to play in all open or member only tournaments events based on tournament criteria.
(Be sure to get Coach's approval on this if applicable.)
- No club voting privileges
- Not responsible for any approved Capital and operating assessments.

Rules for Student / Junior Golfers

- ____ Student Memberships do not have guest privileges on non-public days
- ____ To Rent a cart, must be 16 years old and have valid Driver's license
- ____ No Honor charging privileges without an adult Member co-signer
- ____ Must sign-in on play list before playing (proshop or Cart Barn Honor's Sheet)

This letter provides you with basic information about your membership. Many operational changes have taken place over the last several years, so please read this letter and contact a Board Member if you have questions. The pro shop bulletin board has course rules and current events and our website www.eatonohiogolf.com

General Membership Policies

Your applicable membership, cart & range pass are for the calendar year and not monthly or for 12 months. That is, if you join on May 1st your membership is until the end of the year, not for 12 months. You must contact the Board if you wish to resign.

General Golf Notes

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday & Sundays are Members only days. Not open to public play; however, members may bring guests at all times. The pro shop is closed during these days as a cost savings program.

Members are required to sign the Honor's sheet for either the walker's sheet or the cart sheet posted on the Cart Barn, when the proshop is closed. You may bring guests by putting their name on sheet and your name for billing. Non-members may only play on these days with a member, as their guests. You are responsible for their fees.

Student Memberships do not have cart or guest privileges when the proshop is closed.

Tuesday evenings are reserved for men's league from 4:00 PM till dusk. You can play after 6:00 PM if there is room on tees.

Wednesday mornings the Ladies Golf Association has priority to all holes until 1:00 PM; usually, you may play before 1:00 PM, if you give the ladies total priority to holes they are playing. Female members are encouraged to join, and the LGA conducts weekly events.

On Friday & Saturdays the course is open to the general public and all members. The pro shop is open and all players are to register in the pro shop whether you are walking or taking a cart. Members are always allowed to bring guests. Public must register & pay all fees.

On times when there are tournaments or outings, the course will be closed, sometimes all day. Occasionally you can blend in and play during the tournament, depending on how many are participating & the staff schedule.

Tournaments: Men's golf committee run tournaments throughout the year, including the Club Championship, all male members are welcome. Check bulletin board or website for dates.

Golf fees

Your type of membership designates who can play golf on your membership. Current Guest fees are posted in pro shop. Non-members are subject to green fees at all times, no free golf.

Cart fees

Members can either purchase an annual cart pass or you can pay as you go.

When pro shop is closed, the Honor's clipboard is posted on cart barn. Sign it and if you have a cart pass, check the "cart-pass" box and log in the cart you take. If you do not have a cart pass, you will be billed monthly. This is an Honor's system that has worked well and saved ECC thousands of dollars. In order to take a cart, you must see pro shop staff to sign a liability waiver and to get your personal cart key. Be sure to keep your cart key after you use a cart. Keys are never to be left in unattended cart.

If pro shop is open, you will sign for cart and pay for rental if applicable in the proshop.

Range Use

Range is open to Members with annual range pass everyday subject to weather. Members without a range pass can only purchase range balls when pro shop is open. Range is only open to public when pro shop is open on Friday & Saturday. No range passes are sold to the public.

Student memberships

Student memberships do not have guest privileges or voting privileges. Student members are given a Student Membership Orientation sheet with this membership application.

Clubhouse

The Clubhouse is rented to Leslie Frost for her business, Frosty's catering. She is a tenant, not our manager. Membership issues should be directed to Board members and not Ms. Frost.

When the Clubhouse open, it is open to members and the public. Ms. Frost provides limited food and bar drop-in service. The first floor restroom is available at all times when the Clubhouse & Pro shop is open. When clubhouse is closed, there is a restroom in the cart barn for your use.

All rentals of the Clubhouse and catering services are to be done through Ms. Frost. Members receive a discounted rental on ballroom.
